Please only send the supplies on the list; we will not have storage space for extra supplies. Some supplies will be shared by the class (community supplies). For those supplies, please buy basic supplies (i.e. yellow pencils instead of character or design pencils) as they will be sharing with the class. Please write your child's name on all their supplies, except the community ones.

What is Flexible Seating?

- *varied seating options: crate seats, pillows, scoop chairs, one-leg stools, balls, chairs, bean bags, step stools, floor, and standing
- *also called "alternative seating"

Why is Flexible Seating beneficial?

- *allows student ownership of learning
- *elevated student engagement
- *increased student motivation
- *better health
- *improved behavior
- *motivates students
- *encourages problem-solving
- *supports collaboration, communication, critical thinking, and creativity
- *provides an active outlet for movement (kicking, wiggling, rocking, standing)
- *LOVED by the students and the teacher!
