

# 2022 Pinckneyville #204 Fall Basketball Classic

- Schools:** Albers, Ashley, Central City, Chester, Desoto, Elverado, Ewing, Johnston City, New Horizon, Oakdale, Pinckneyville #50, Pinckneyville #204, Sesser-Valier, Sparta, Tamaroa/St. Bruno's (Pinckneyville), and Waltonville.
- Seeding/Bracket:** The tournament is seeded using prior knowledge of teams. I also try to take into consideration where teams are from, trying to pair you with teams you would typically not see during the regular season.
- Home Team:** The home team will be the team listed on the top of the bracket. The home team will wear their "light" uniforms. Home team will also be responsible for Official Book.
- Locker Room:** Since teams will be sharing the locker rooms, with other teams; it is suggested that teams have their own valuable bag for each game.
- Trophy & Awards:** A trophy will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> Place. The trophy will be awarded Friday, November 12<sup>th</sup>, immediately following the championship game. The 15 member all-tournament team will be announced at the conclusion of each member's final game on Friday.
- Game Times:** Game times for each game are listed on the tournament pairings. These times are approximate. Games will begin ten minutes after the conclusion of the previous game.
- Basketballs:** Basketballs for warming up will be provided by the host school. Only those players warming up for their immediate game will be permitted on the floor to shoot. Water will be provided for each team at the bench area.
- Hospitality Room:** There will be a hospitality room provided. Coaches, Athletic Directors, Scorekeepers, Bus Drivers, and Administrators are welcome.
- Entry Fee:** The entry fee is \$100. This is necessary to help with the funding needs of the tournament. Each team is guaranteed 4 games.
