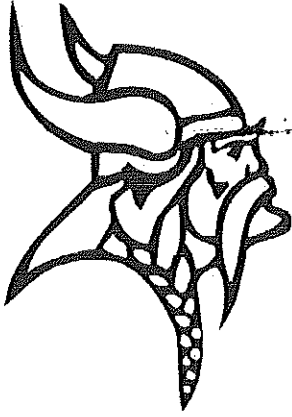
Certificate of Residency

Oakdale Grade School Internet Policy, Internet Rules and Use Agreement

Proper use of the Internet

With the coming of the internet, students have been given access to numerous educational materials as well as those not suitable for the school setting. Therefore, all students must receive instructions regarding procedures, ethics, and security involving the use of the internet before being allowed to log on to the system. Having installed the internet into Oakdale Grade School, the Board of Education has established the following guidelines for internet use:

- A. **Internet shall be used for educational purposes only:** The purpose of the internet is to expand educational opportunities for students and teachers by providing access to unique resources and meaningful communication with other educators. To remain as an internet user, a student must be consistent with the goals established by the classroom teacher(s).
- B. **All users must demonstrate proper behavior and maintain proper security on the internet:** Students should be polite while using the internet. Any e-mail transmission should be pre-approved by the teacher(s) prior to its use by student. Social media (ex. Face book) is not permitted at school. Students should not give out personal information such as addresses and phone number over the internet. Students should only go on sites approved by the teachers(s).
- C. **Offensive Materials:** Despite the best efforts from the district, it is impossible for the district staff to keep students clear from all areas which parents might find objectionable. Despite the potential pitfalls, the district believes that the advantages of internet use outweigh the disadvantages. Parents should consider potential risks before giving their children permission to use the internet. District staff will do the following to insure that students access only appropriate materials.
 - 1. Student's use of the internet will be supervised at all times by staff members.
 - 2. Students will use the internet for educational purposes. Staff will attempt to direct students to sites which support the educational goals of the school
 - 3. If students unintentionally access restricted areas of the internet, staff will direct them to exit such sites without delay.
- D. **District/Student Responsibilities:** In granting permission for their student(s) to use the internet, parents agree that it is the user's responsibility not to access offensive or obscene materials. Although staff will take all reasonable steps to insure responsible use of the internet, the district cannot guarantee total control of the content on the internet. Transmission of any material in violation of local, state, & national laws is prohibited.
- E. **Penalties for misuse:** Students who overtly violate the district's Internet Policy will be subjected to the following penalties:
 - 1. A two-week restriction from using the internet on the first rule violation
 - 2. A one month restriction from using the internet upon a second rule violation
 - 3. Three violations of these policy/rules will result in a total restriction from using the internet for the remainder of the school year.
 - 4. Any violation of local, state, and national law will result in automatic restriction from internet use for the remainder of the school year. In such cases, the school reserves the right to contact law enforcement officials. This includes, but is not limited to, copyrighted material, threatening material, pornography or obscene material.

Parents should read the preceding information carefully. Those wishing their children to access the internet should sign the form and return it to the school. Failure to return the form to the school indicates that the parent(s) **do not** want their children to access the internet.
